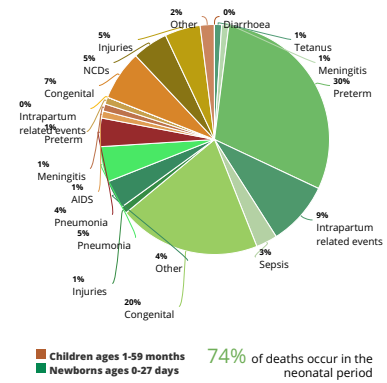
### Causes of Maternal Death - ---

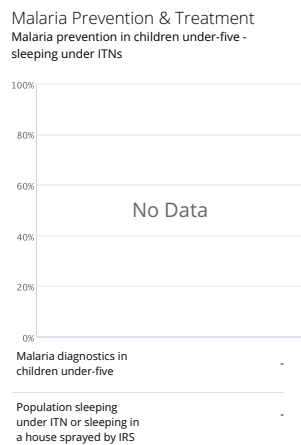
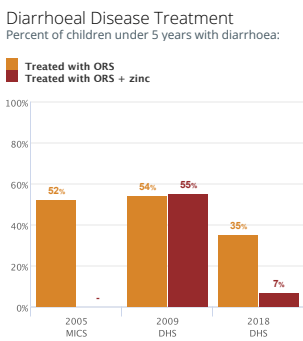
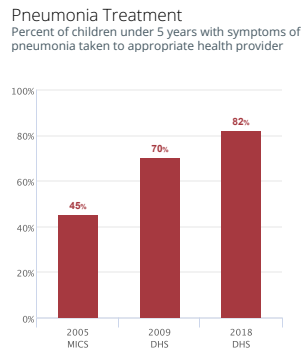
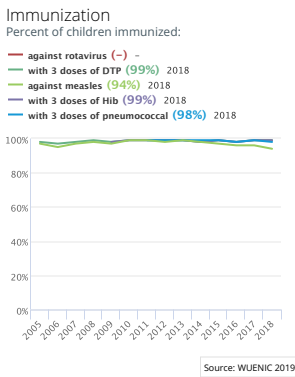
### Causes of Death Under-Five - 2017

Globally nearly half of child deaths are attributable to undernutrition

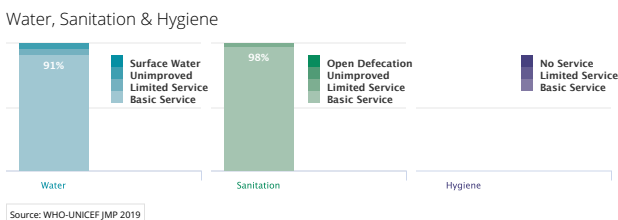


74% of deaths occur in the neonatal period
