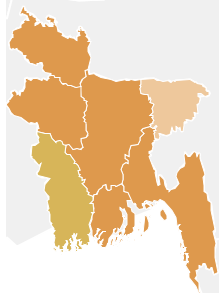

Composite Coverage Index

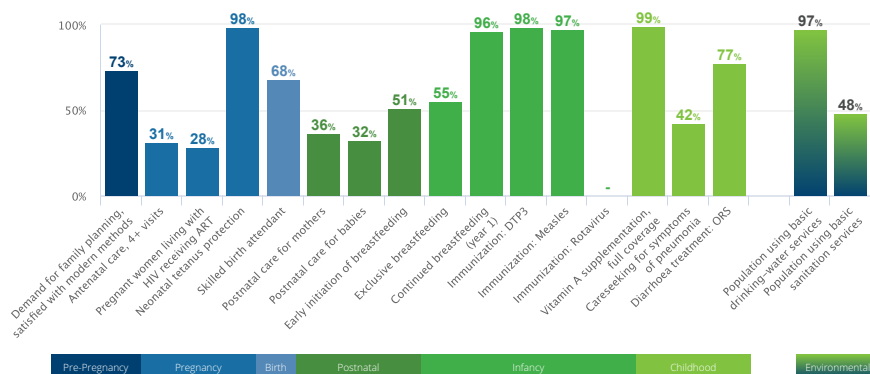

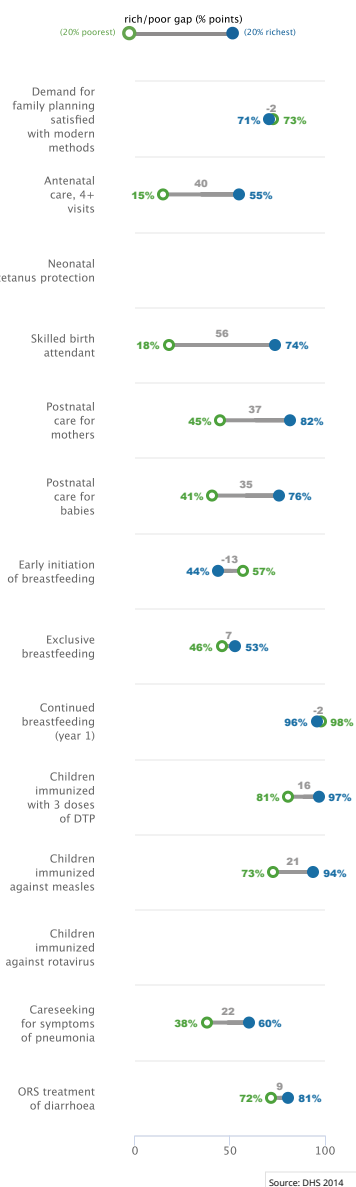

Percentage of those in need receiving coverage of key interventions across the continuum of care

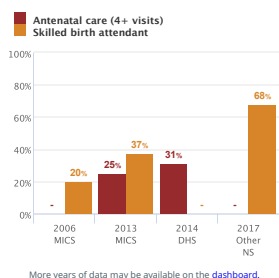

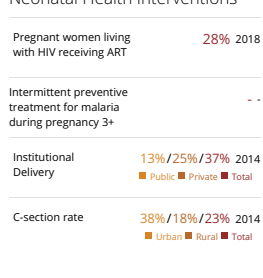
