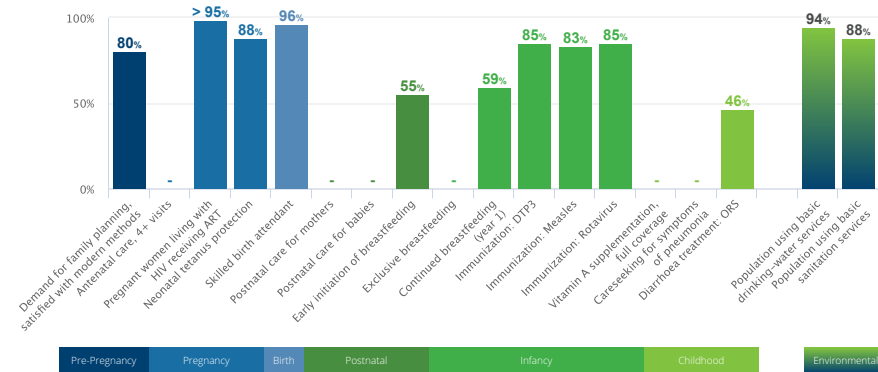

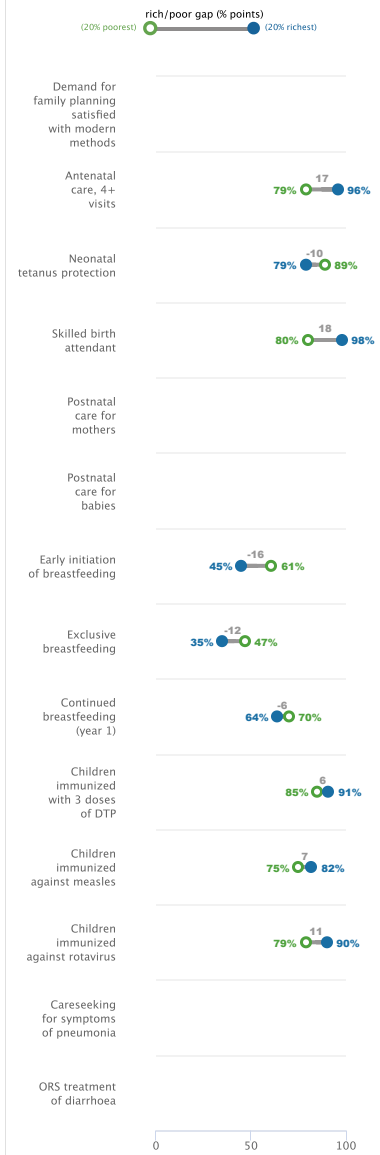


Continuum of Care Coverage

Percentage of those in need receiving coverage of key interventions across the continuum of care

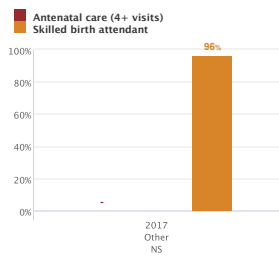

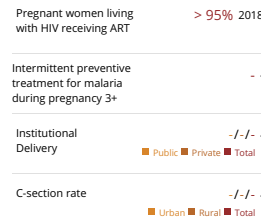

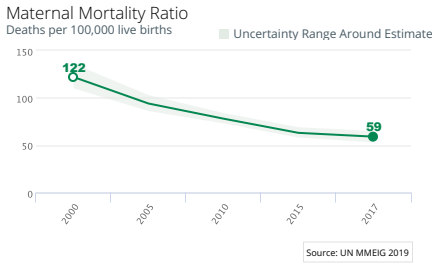


Breastfeeding Practices



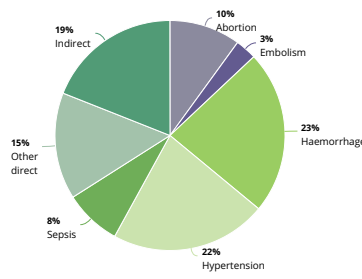

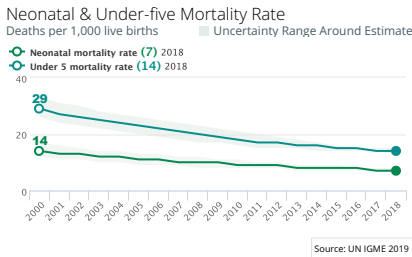
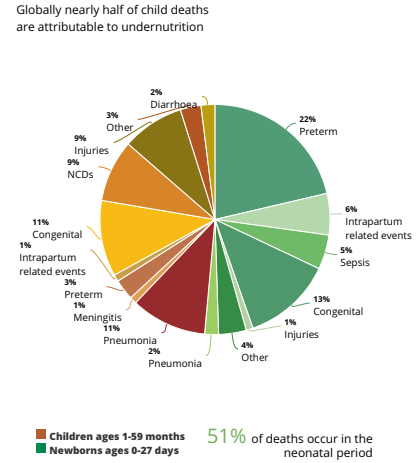


### Causes of Maternal Death - 2014

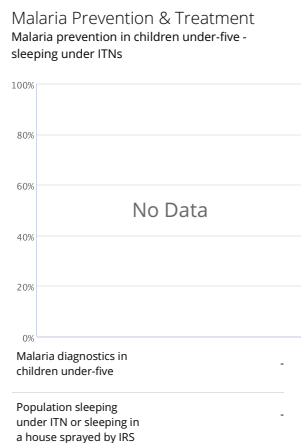
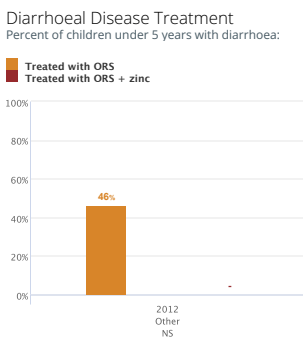
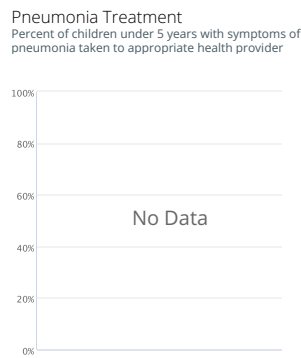
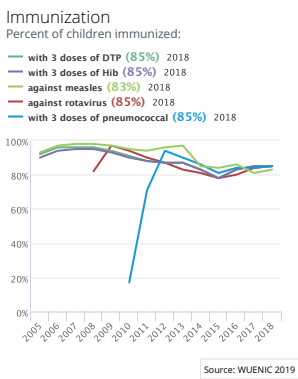
Regional estimates for Latin America and Caribbean



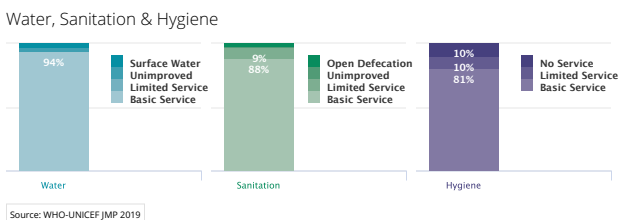
### Causes of Death Under-Five - 2017
