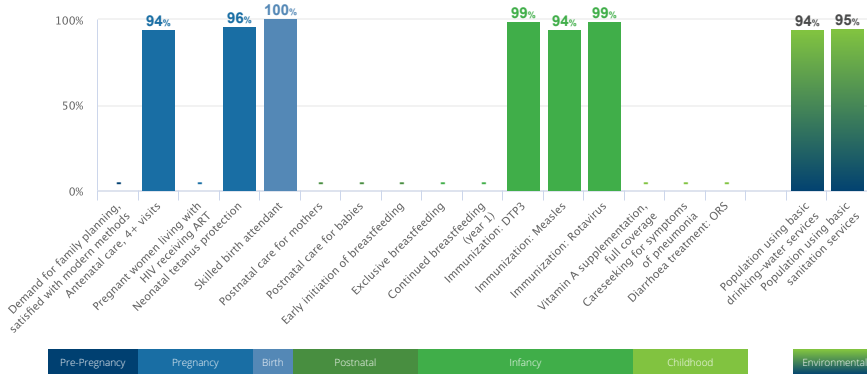

Percentage of those in need receiving coverage of key interventions across the continuum of care

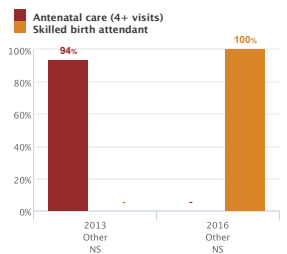

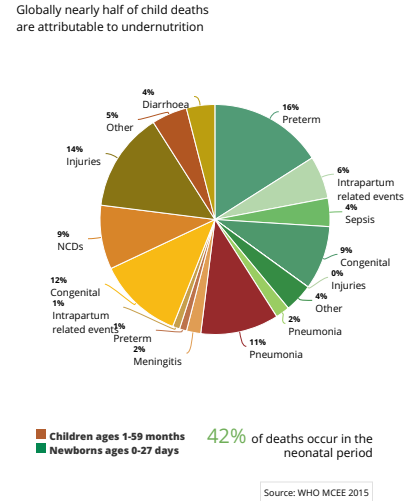


Causes of Maternal Death - 2014

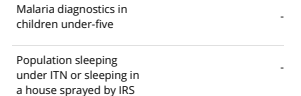
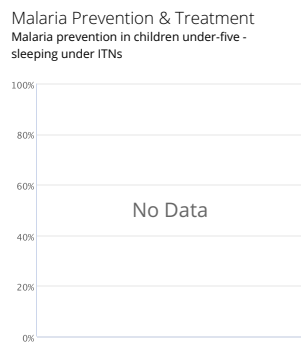
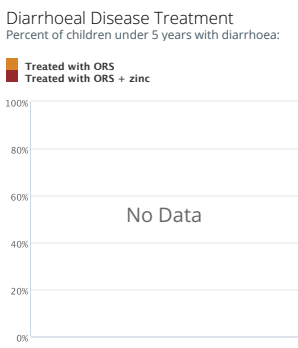
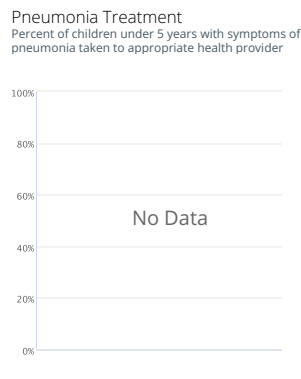
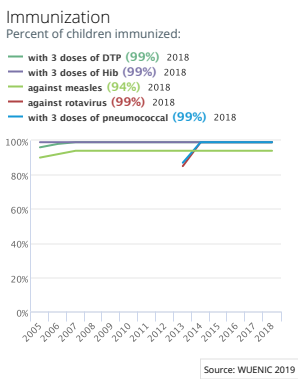
Regional estimates for Oceania



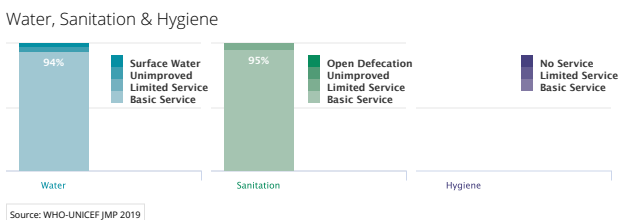
Causes of Death Under-Five - 2017
