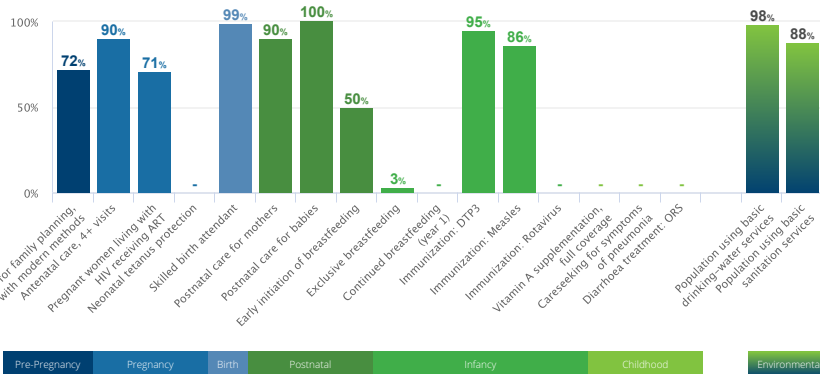

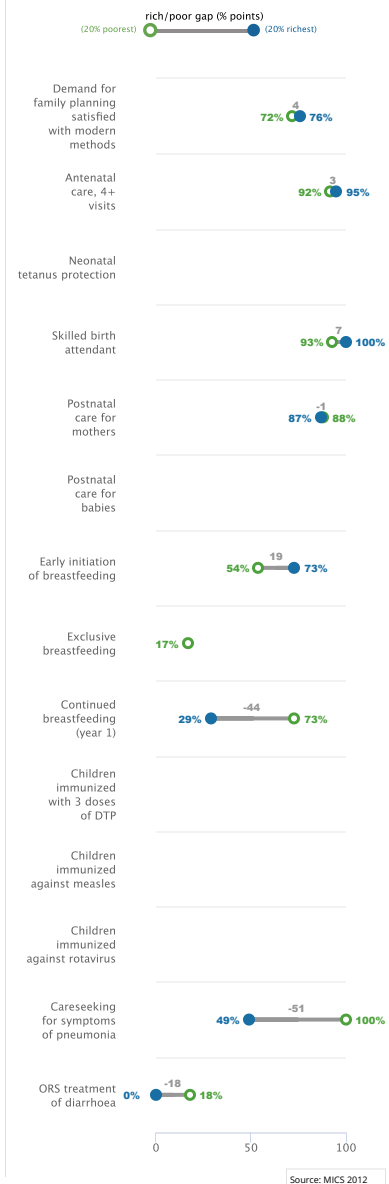

Percentage of those in need receiving coverage of key interventions across the continuum of care

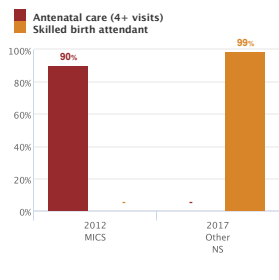

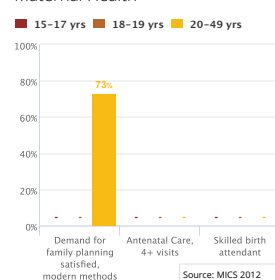

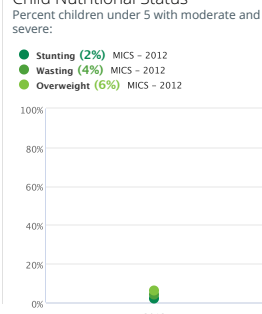

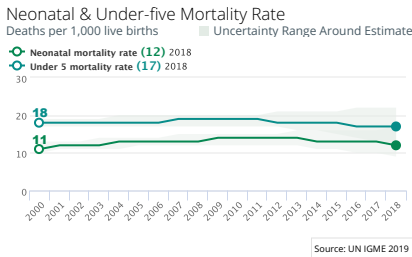

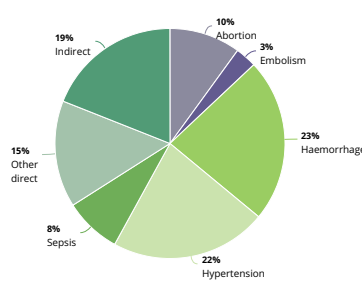

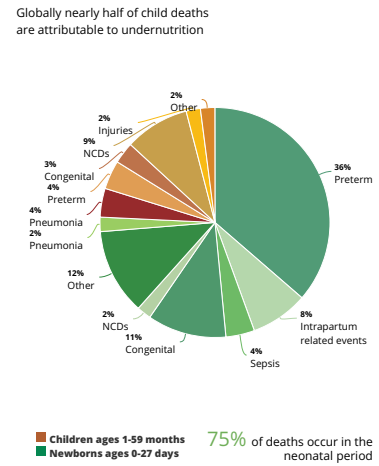
Causes of Maternal Death - 2014

Regional estimates for Latin America and Caribbean



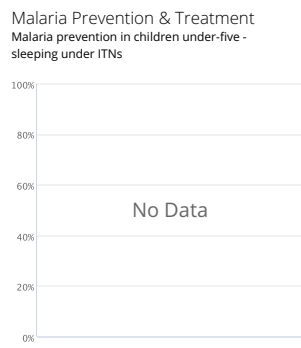
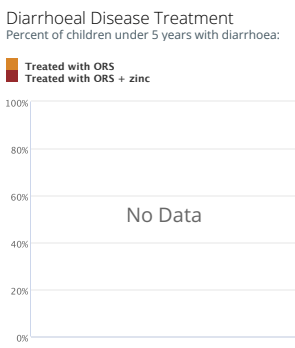
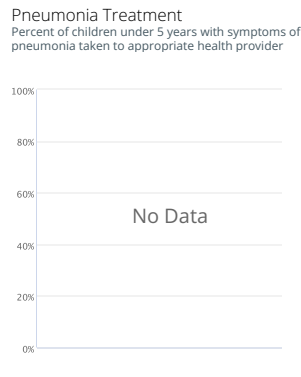
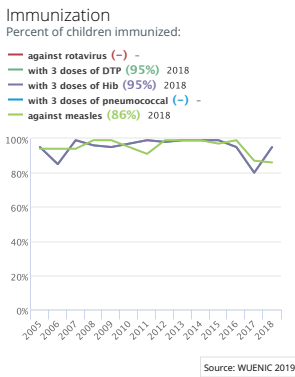

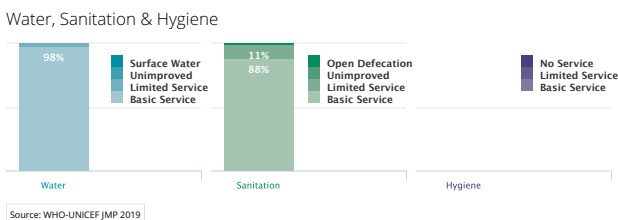
