

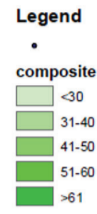
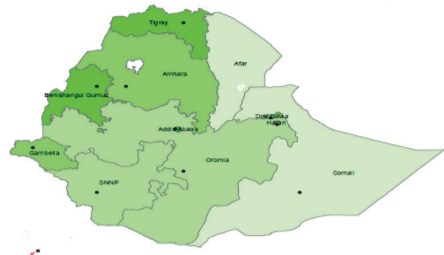

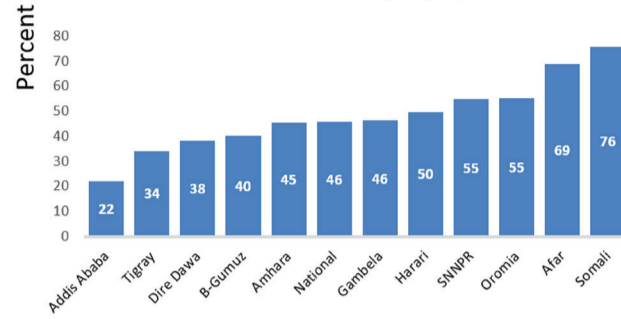


Composite Coverage Index

National CCI: 54%

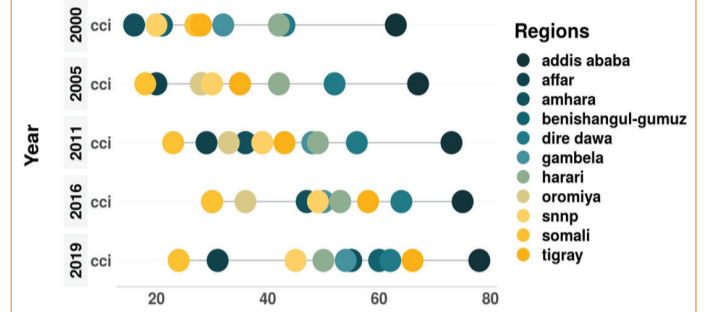


Health coverage gap



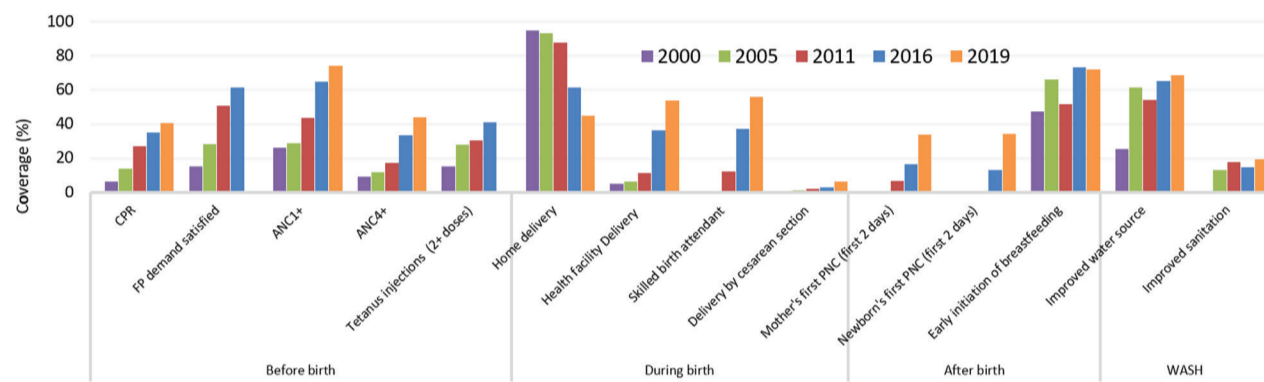

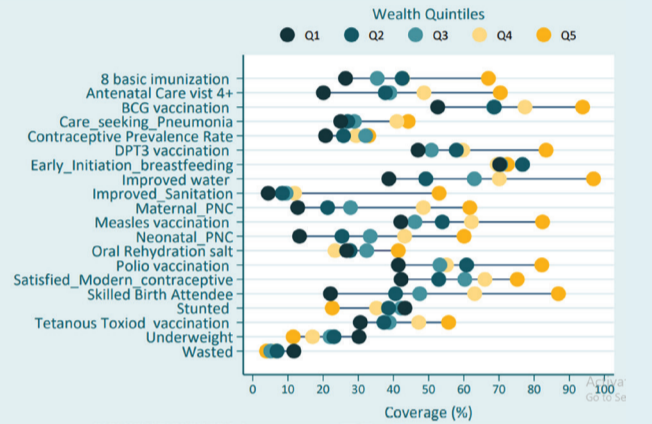


Continuum of care coverage

Percentage of those in need receiving coverage of key interventions across the continuum of care

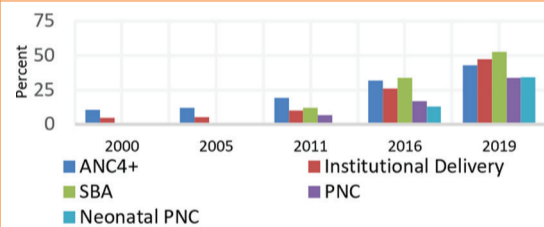


Coverage of key interventions by wealth quintile and Residence, 2019

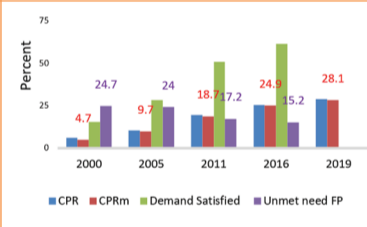

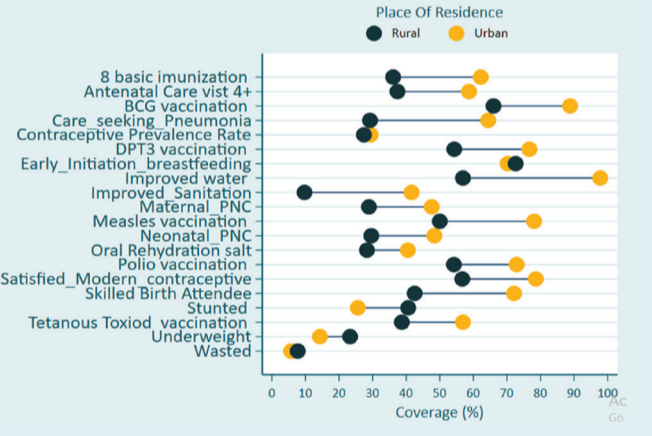
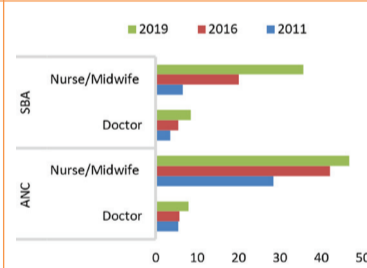

Interventions: Percentage of skilled personnel providing ANC4+ visits and SBA



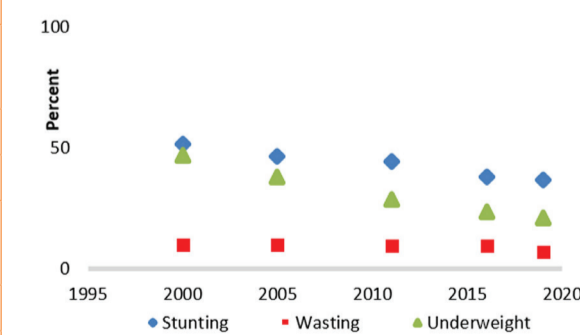

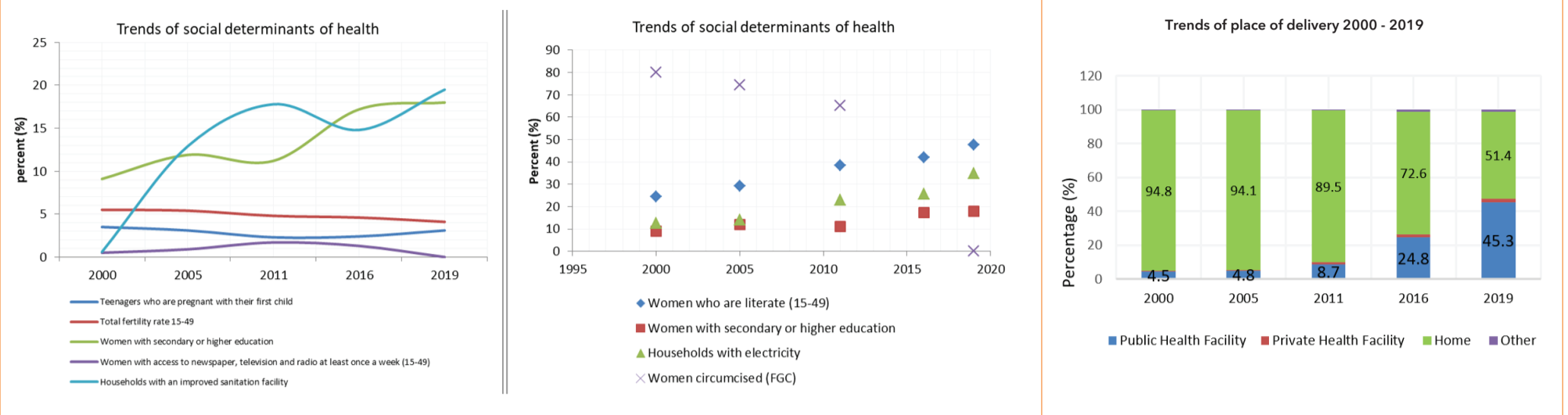
Percentage of children under-5 with moderate and severe stunting, wasting and under weight



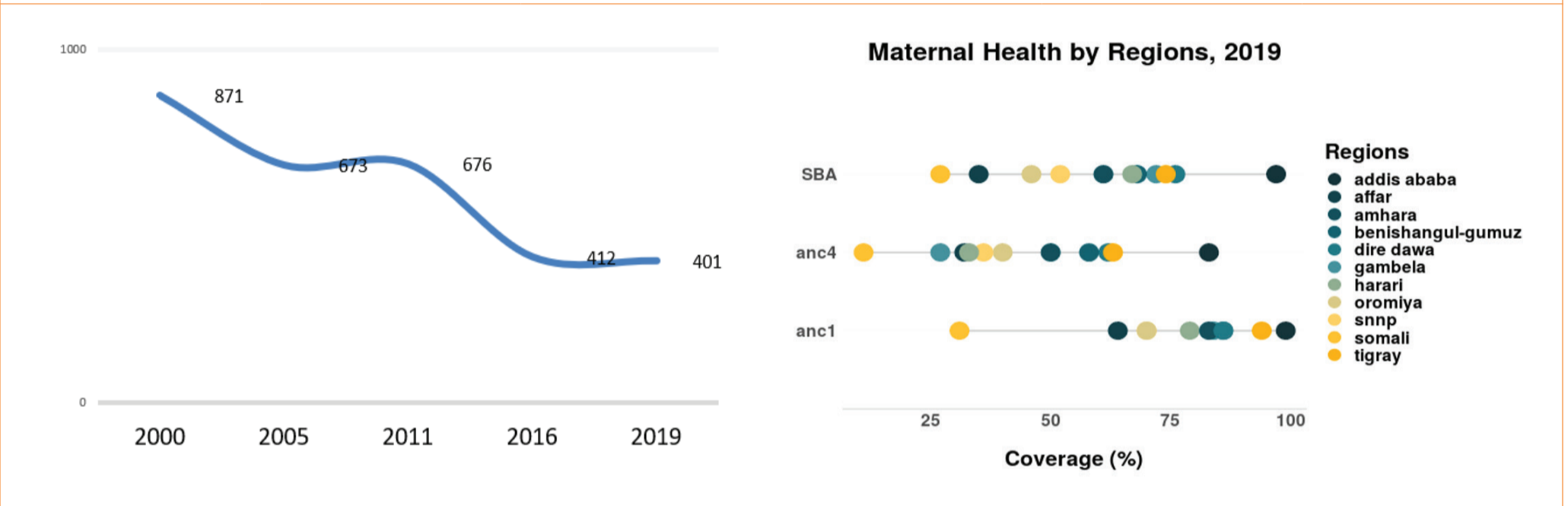

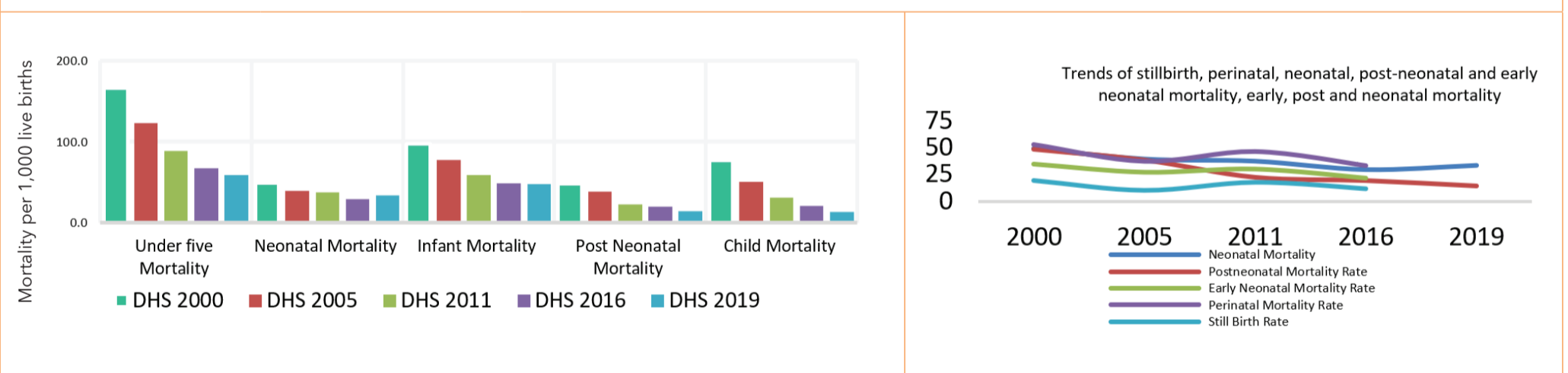

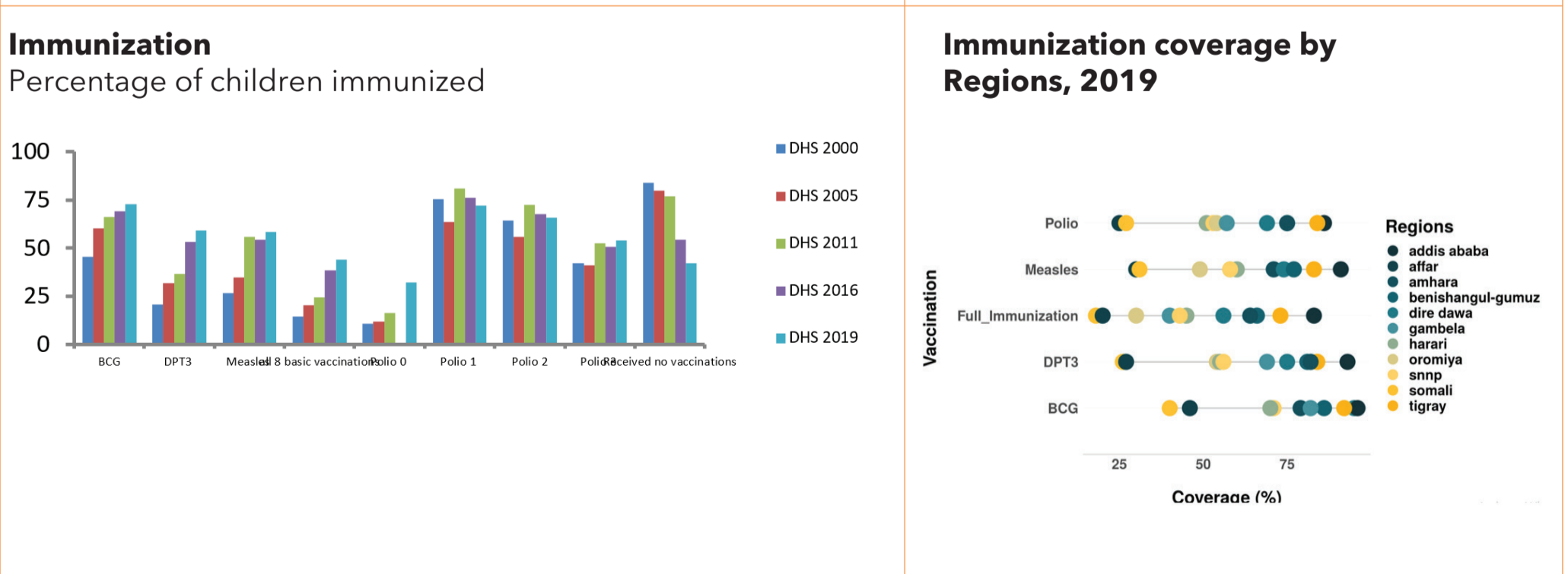
Maternal mortality ratio

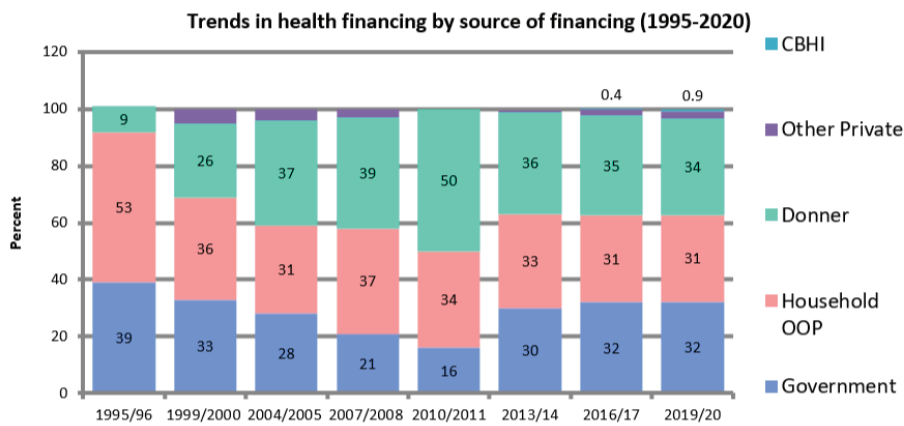

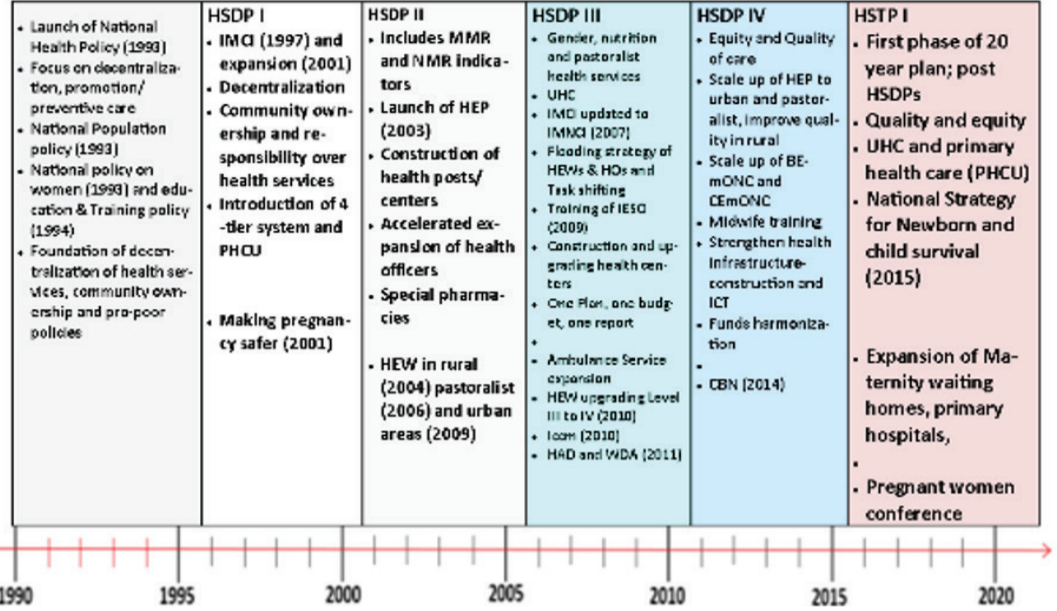

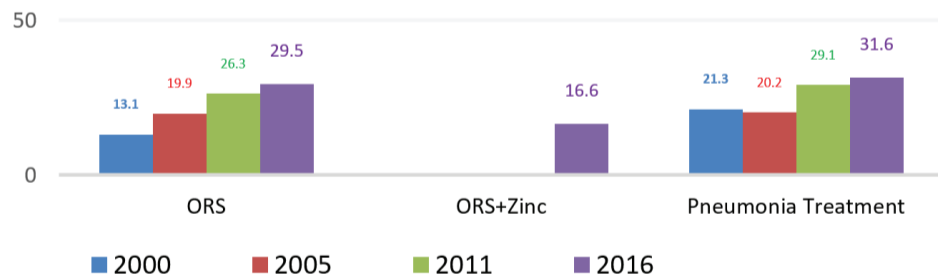

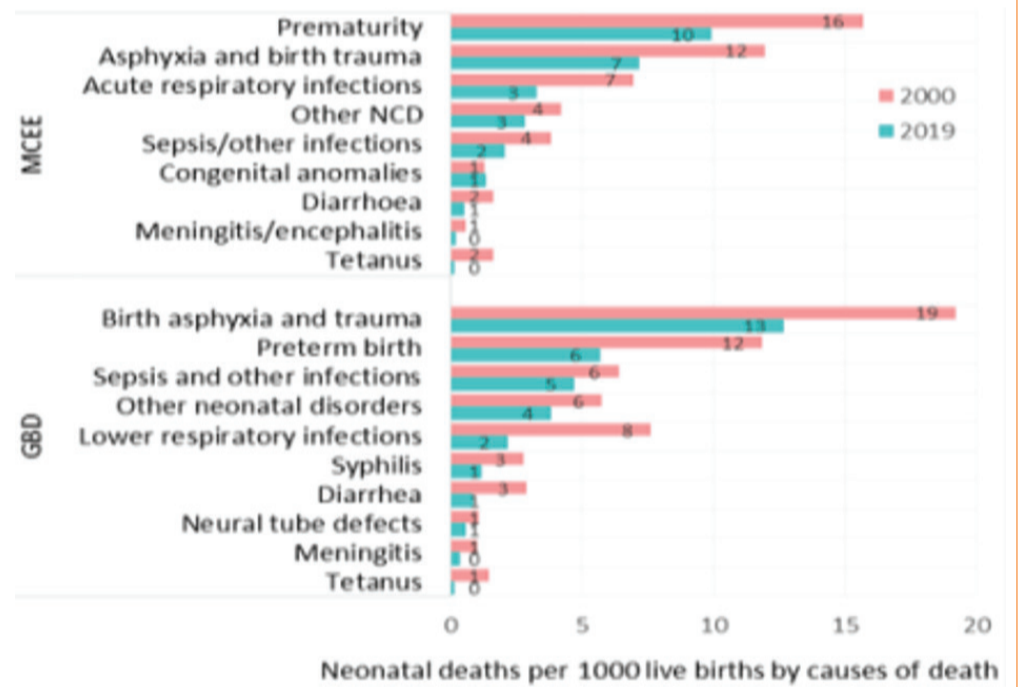


Childhood diseases (Diarrheal Pneumonia) treatment
